Net (5-7yrs) Information – 2022

EENC runs a Net Squad for 5 – 7 year olds. It is part of the ANZ NetSetGo is Netball Australia's only junior entry netball program. It has been developed to provide children from 5 to 9 years with the best possible learning and playing experience to develop a positive introduction to netball, ensuring enjoyment and continued participation.

ANZ NetSetGo program incorporates skill activities, minor games and modified competition in a fun and safe environment.

The Net Squad is a fantastic way to introduce keen young netballers to the game and introduce the idea of competition in a fun and very relaxed way.

The participants will learn the fundamental aspects of the game of netball, including ball skills, catching, passing and game play.

Everyone registered will receive at Net Set Go participant pack from Netball NSW

What is involved?

Training - Training is usually on **Thursday or Friday afternoon** at Ferntree Netball Courts, Ferntree Rd Engadine. (depending on coach and court availability). This will usually start a couple of weeks before the Saturday games commence.

Saturday Games - In addition to weekday training, Net squad has round robin games with other Sutherland Shire teams on a Saturday usually start at about **12noon and run for about 45 minutes.**

Games are played on grass at Seymour Shaw Netball courts, Miranda.

The first game will commence on **Saturday 7 May 2022 – Day 4**, and will run for 10 weeks. The last game will be on Saturday 31 July 2021, and a presentation from Sutherland Shire Netball Association (SSNA) is held after this last game.

What does it cost?

Cost is \$102.03. Active Kids vouchers can be used. Contact Service NSW to obtain these.

A uniform consisting of both skirt and shirt will be provided to all Net players. This is to be washed and returned at the end of the season.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is it okay for my child to play if they haven't played netball before?

Absolutely ok. The aim of NetSetGo is to equip each child with netball skills, helping them catch, throw and pass the ball while learning positional play during the game of netball.

Will my child play in a team with friends?

Yes, this can be dependent on numbers at registration but playing with friends is encouraged and the club will do their best ensuring your child is placed in a team with friends.
